Dear Shri Singh,

Kindly refer to the meeting held in your chamber on 06.07.2011 on the subject "Execution of MGNREGA Scheme by the Fisheries Department, Government of West Bengal". As discussed in the meeting, I would like to request you to kindly consider the following actions by the Panchayat & RD Department :-

- (i) Issue instructions to declare all CEO, FFDA as PIAs with copies to DMs & Director of Fisheries.
- (ii) Issue advice to all districts to impart training to FFDA & also provide training kit including uploading software;
- (iii) Issue advice to DMs to allot ad hoc contingency costs for preliminary activities regarding scheme preparation etc. at the following rates :-
  - a) Rs.10.00 lakh for each of the 19 FFDA and
  - b) Rs.20.00 lakh extra for CEO, FFDA, South 24-Parganas for HQ costs;
- (iv) to clarify if a NREGA scheme can include cost of fish fingerlings, lime, manure, fish feed, etc. in 40% material cost component.
