



MGNREGA Ensures Livelihood Security to Women headed Household

S mt. Khirobala Roy South Berubari Gram Panchayat, was finding it difficult to make both ends meet. She was having a land but it was of no use and was not fit for cultivation. This woman led household was adjudged BPL and has a BPL card. Her only son was a daily wage labourer. She expressed her desire to develop her waste land and make it fit for cultivation. Assessing the need, South Berubari Gram Panchayat of which Smt. Khirobala Roy was the resident, decided to develop the same through MGNREGS work. 1665 man-days were generated during the work. 200 households got engaged in the work and about 240 individuals joined hands to work on the scheme. 61 Rural ST households and 136 rural SC households worked together for making the dream of Smt. Nirobala come true.

Now the land is fit for cultivation. Smt. Khirobala Roy has now started to cultivate in her own land to earn her livelihood.
